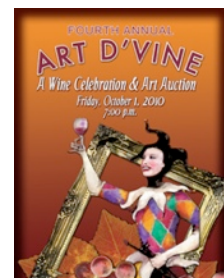
• *Queen's Luncheon & Fashion Show (Peanut Fest Kick-off)*
