• *Suffolk Farmers' Market*

Held beneath brightly striped tents at "Market Park" (the mini-park adjacent to the Seaboard Station Railroad Museum at 326 N. Main Street), the Market offers the very best in locally grown fruit and vegetables, homemade jams and jellies, fresh seafood, cut flowers, handcrafted jewelry and more. Operates rain or shine on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Wednesdays from 3 to 6 p.m. through September. Free and open to the public.

• *National Take-Back Initiative Day*

On Saturday, September 25, 2010, the Drug Enforcement Administration Richmond District will partner with Virginia State Police, Suffolk Police Department and other local agencies to conduct a state wide prescription drug take-back day, at the College Drive Walmart from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., in order to reduce the amount of unused prescription drugs present in the Commonwealth of Virginia. The event, National Take-Back Initiative Day, is a collaborative effort to remove potentially dangerous prescription drugs from our nation's homes. A national take-back day will provide a unified opportunity for the public to surrender expired, unwanted, or unused pharmaceutical controlled substances and other medications to law enforcement officers for destruction. This program provides an opportunity for everyone to clean out their medicine cabinets. Controlled, non- controlled, and over the counter substances may be collected. No questions or requests for identification will be made. Participants may dispose of medication in its original container or by removing the medication from its container. If an original container is submitted, we ask that you remove any identifying information from the prescription label. All solid dosage pharmaceutical product and liquids in consumer containers may be accepted. Liquid products, such as cough syrup, should remain sealed in their original container. Intravenous solutions, injectibles, and syringes will not be accepted due to potential hazard
