**City Offices Closed in Observance of Lee-Jackson  
and Martin Luther King Holidays**

SUFFOLK, VA (January 11, 2011) In observance of Lee Jackson Day and Martin Luther King Day, Suffolk City offices will be closed on Friday, January 14, 2011, and Monday, January 17, 2011. Normal operations will resume Tuesday, January 18 at 8:30 a.m. The City observes all State-designated holidays. Lee-Jackson Day and Martin Luther King Day are considered holidays for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all State Offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City libraries** are closed on Friday, January 14, 2011 through Monday, January 17, 2011. All Library branches reopen at their normal times on Tuesday, January 18. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** remains open on it's normal schedule throughout the holidays. The **Suffolk Museum** is closed Friday, January 14, 2011 through Monday, January 17, 2011. The Museum reopens Tuesday, January 18 at 10 a.m.

All **Suffolk Joint Use Recreation Centers** as well as the **East Suffolk Recreation Center** will operate on regular hours on Friday, January 14. All Joint Use Recreation Centers are closed on Saturday, January 15 and Sunday, January 16. **East Suffolk Recreation Center** will operate on regular hours on Saturday, January 15, but is closed on Sunday, January 16. All Joint Use Recreation Centers, as well as the **East Suffolk Recreation Center**, will be closed on Monday, January 17.

**Suffolk's four major parks-** Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek, will be open on regular hours Friday, January 14, Saturday, January 15, Sunday, January 16 and Monday, January 17; however, no park attendant will be on duty.

Trash will be collected on a normal schedule on Friday, January 14, 2011. **Suffolk Public Works Department** reminds you that trash must be placed at curbside no later than 7 a.m. on the day of collection. For more information on refuse collection, please call Public Works at 514-7630.
