USJFCOM Workforce Assistance Hotline Goes Live 757-461-7537

March 25, 2011 – A hotline dedicated to providing assistance to those affected by the U. S. Joint Forces Command (USJFCOM) transformation has been established. The number, 757-461-7537, is the first in a number of programs and resources that will be made available to those who will be displaced or to those whose businesses might be impacted. The USJFCOM Assistance Hotline number is being managed by Opportunity, Inc. who will be able to provide resources through their current One-Stop Career Center programs and/or One-on-One career coaching and preparation.

A website to provide further assistance is currently under construction. Additionally, a One Stop Career Center dedicated for those impacted by the USJFCOM transformation, known as: *The Virginia Regional Center for USJFCOM Workforce Transition Center and Business Development* in the Bridgeway Technology Center I building in Suffolk, Va., will be open in late April 2011.
