### City Offices Closed in Observance Lee-Jackson Day and Martin Luther King Jr. Day

In observance of Lee-Jackson Day and Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Suffolk City offices will be closed on Friday, January 15, and Monday, January 18. Normal operations will resume Tuesday, January 19, at 8:30 a.m. The city observes all state-designated holidays. Lee-Jackson Day and Martin Luther King Jr. Day are considered holidays for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City libraries** will be closed Friday, January 15 through Monday, January 18, and will reopen on Tuesday, January 19, at 9 a.m. The **Suffolk Museum** will be closed Friday, January 15, through Monday, January 18, and will reopen on Tuesday, January 19, at 10 a.m. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** will be open on Friday, January 15, and Monday, January 18.

**Suffolk's four major parks** – Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek will remain open through the holiday weekend; however, no park attendant will be on duty.

The **Public Works Department** will pick up trash according to the following schedule:

- There is no change to Friday's (January 15) schedule.
- Monday's (January 18) route will be picked up on Tuesday, January 19
- Tuesday's (January 19) route will be picked up on Wednesday, January 20
- Wednesday (January 20) route will be picked up on Thursday, January 21
- Thursday's (January 21) route will be picked up on Friday, January 22
- Friday's (January 22) route will be picked up on Saturday, January 23
