City Offices Closed In Observance of Memorial Day

SUFFOLK, VA (May 25, 2010) In observance of Memorial Day, Suffolk City offices will be closed Monday, May 31, 2010. Normal operations will resume Tuesday, June 1, at 8:30 a.m. The city observes all state-designated holidays. Memorial Day is considered a holiday for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City libraries** will be closed Monday, May 31, and will reopen on Tuesday, June 1, at 9 a.m. The **Suffolk Museum** will be closed Monday, May 31, and will reopen on Tuesday, June 1, at 10 a.m. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** will remain open on Monday, May 31.

Suffolk's four major parks – Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek will remain open during the holiday; however, no park attendant will be on duty.

The **Public Works Department** will pick up trash according to the following schedule:

- Monday's (May 31) route will be picked up on Tuesday, June 1.
- Tuesday's (June 1) route will be picked up on Wednesday, June 2.
- Wednesday's (June 2) route will be picked up on Thursday, June 3.
- Thursday's (June 3) route will be picked up on Friday, June 4.
- Friday's (June 4) route will be picked up on Saturday, June 5.

Trash must be placed at curbside no later than 7 a.m. on the day of collection. For more information on refuse collection, please call Public Works at 514-7630.
