City Offices Closed In Observance of Thanksgiving Holiday

In observance of the Thanksgiving holiday, Suffolk City offices will close at noon on Wednesday, November 25, 2009, and remain closed Thursday, November 26, and Friday, November 27.

Normal operations will resume Monday, November 30, at 8:30 a.m. The city observes all state-designated holidays. Thanksgiving is considered a holiday for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City libraries** will close at noon on Wednesday, November 25, and will reopen on Monday, November 30, at 9 a.m. The **Suffolk Museum** will close at noon on Wednesday, November 25, and will reopen on Tuesday, December 1, at 10 a.m. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** close at noon on Wednesday, November 25, and will reopen on Saturday, November 28 at 9 a.m.

Suffolk's four major parks – Lone Star Lakes will close at noon on Wednesday, November 25, and reopen on Saturday, November 28 at 8 a.m.; Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek will remain open during the holiday; however, no park attendant will be on duty. Full staffing will resume on Saturday, November 28 at 8 a.m.

The **Public Works Department** will pick up trash according to the following schedule:

- Thursday's (November 26) route will be picked up on Friday, November 27
- Friday's (November 27) route will be picked up on Saturday, November 28
