INVESTIGATION CONTINUES IN ST. JAMES AVENUE FIRE

SUFFOLK, VA (October 14, 2009) Suffolk Fire and Rescue are seeking information from the public on a fire that destroyed two homes and damaged a third last week. On October 8 at approximately 4:30 a.m., Suffolk Fire and Rescue responded to a structure fire at 119 St. James Ave. The fire resulted in the complete loss of two residential structures with a third home heavily damaged. The fire also damaged or destroyed four vehicles. The cause of the fire remains under investigation by the Suffolk Fire Marshal's Office.

Fire Marshals ask that anyone with any information regarding this incident call Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U Up. Remember when calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If the caller's information leads to an arrest, they could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
