**FINAL UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, VA (January 19, 2011) Suffolk Fire and Rescue cleared the scene at 10:58 and all residents were permitted to return to their homes.

**UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, VA (January 19, 2011) Virginia Natural Gas has arrived on scene at 10:06 a.m. Twelve homes in the immediate area in the Kensington Park subdivision were notified, resulting in three adults and one pet being evacuated. Residents on Wexford Drive East and Wexford Drive West, in the Wexford Downs neighborhood near the area, were notified of the situation and advised to stay in place.

**Suffolk Fire and Rescue on Scene of Gas Leak**

SUFFOLK, VA (January 19, 2011) Suffolk Fire and Rescue and Suffolk Police are currently on scene of a gas leak in the 200 block of Craftsman Circle, located off of Kensington Boulevard in the Kensington Park subdivision. A contractor

doing work at that location notified police that a line had been damaged at approximately 9:08 a.m.

Several homes in the area have been evacuated.
