UPDATE

SUFFOLK, Va. (August 11, 2010) The two patients are now being airlifted to Sentara Norfolk Hospital.

SUFFOLK, Va. (August 11, 2010) – Firefighters are on the scene of a fire that has displaced four. Members of Suffolk Fire and Rescue Fire Department responded to a residential, structure fire in the 3300 blk. of Waters Ave. The fire was called in by a neighbor as a kitchen fire and was reported at 12:45 a.m.

The blaze was brought under control at 1:30.

One adult and one child were transported to Sentara Obici due to smoke inhalation. Four people, one adult and three children, were displaced and are being aided in relocation by the Suffolk Chapter of the American Red Cross.

The Suffolk Fire Marshal is currently on scene. The cause of the fire remains under investigation.
