UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA. (June 7, 2010) The cause of the fire on Peanut Drive today remains under investigation by the Office of the Fire Marshal. Suffolk firefighters were able to contain fire damage to primarily the second floor.

The two story structure sustained approx. \$10,000 in damage to the structure and \$8,000 in content loss. One firefighter was transported to Sentara Obici Hospital where he was treated for heat exhaustion and released.

The homes four occupants were displaced. It is unknown if they sought the assistance of the Red Cross.

UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (June 7, 2010) The fire was called under control at 10:07. There has been no report of injuries. The Fire Marshal is in route to the scene.
