SUFFOLK, Virginia (February 11, 2009) A fifty-year old Suffolk man has been arrested and charged with sexually assaulting a woman who applied for a job at his residence. Police advise that on February 9, 2009, a thirty-seven-year-old woman answered a newspaper ad for a housekeeper at a residence in the 200 blk. of River Inlet Rd. The woman reports that while Gregory J. Ziglar was showing her the residence that she was to clean, he sexually assaulted her. The victim left the residence and reported the incident to police.

Ziglar was arrested today and charged with one count of rape and one count of abduction. A search warrant was also executed at his residence. He is currently being held in Western Tidewater Regional Jail without bond.

Police are asking anyone that is familiar with this ad, which was placed within the last thirty days, or who might have also answered the ad, to contact investigators. Detective Carlos Gonzalez and Detective Joyce Williams are the lead detectives 757-514-7945 757-514-7944.
