SUFFOLK, Va. (March 3, 2009) Suffolk Police are currently investigating a burglary and are asking for the public's assistance. On February 26, 2009, during the daytime hours, suspect(s) unknown forced entry into a residence in the 7500 blk. of Indian Trail Rd. The suspect(s) ransacked a bedroom and removed a Ruger 357 revolver and two jewelry boxes. One of the pieces of jewelry stolen was a 1.5 carat diamond ring with four rubies valued at \$32,000.

Suffolk Police are releasing a photo of the ring in case someone has seen the item. Detective Neil Boone is the lead investigator.

Anyone with information on this case is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line callers never have to leave their name or appear in court. If the caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could receive a reward of up to \$1,000.
