UPDATE

SUFFOLK, Va. (March 10, 2009) The seventeen year old driver in last night's single vehicle accident, Cody T. Wheeler, of the 400 blk. of Manning Bridge Rd, is currently in critical condition at Sentara Norfolk Hospital. Wheeler was operating a 1997 Chevrolet Lumina east bound on New Rd. when the vehicle exited the roadway. The vehicle flipped several times and Wheeler was ejected.

Status is unavailable on Wheeler's passenger, Thomas Warren, however his injuries were not considered to be life threatening.

SINGLE VEHICLE ACCIDENT SENDS TWO TO HOSPITAL

SUFFOLK, Va. (March 9, 2009) – Suffolk Police are currently working a single vehicle accident, which has sent two to the hospital. The accident occurred in 9100 blk. of New Rd. at 6:39 p.m.

Early indications are that the vehicle ran off the road and flipped several times. The seventeen year old, male driver was ejected from the vehicle. He was transported to Sentara Norfolk Hospital via Nightingale helicopter. A male

passenger, age 27, was also injured. He was ground transported to Southhampton Memorial Hospital.

The cause of the accident is under investigation. Officer James Salmon is the lead investigator.
