UPDATE

SUFFOLK, Va. (March 30, 2009) Autopsies performed today confirmed that Jeanette Brabrand and Paul Bamberg both died of gunshot wounds. Preliminary investigation leads police to believe that Bamberg was the victim of a homicide and Bradrand was the victim of suicide. Investigation into the incident continues.

POLICE IDENTIFY SUBJECTS IN UNDETERMINED DEATHS

SUFFOLK, Va. (March 29, 2009) Suffolk Police have identified the two subjects found deceased in a residence last night. At approx. 6:30 p.m., police were called to a home in the 600 blk. of North Broad St. in reference to performing a welfare check.

At the Riverview home, police found Jeanette Brabrand, 57, and Paul Bamberg, 53. Bradbrand was located in a bedroom. Bamberg was found in a study. Both were deceased.

Police have not released a cause of death. Autopsies are scheduled to be performed tomorrow. Detective Herbert Bruce is the lead investigator.

The Broad Street address is listed as the home address for both victims.
