**ARRESTS MADE IN BURGLARIES TO
SCHOOL CLASSROOMS**

SUFFOLK, Va. (April 17, 2009) An alert citizen and quick response by police led to the apprehension of two juveniles in the burglary of several mobile classrooms at a local elementary school. On April 16, just before 6:30 p.m., a citizen observed two suspicious subjects around the doors of the mobile classrooms located at Kilby Shores Elementary.

The mobile classrooms have been the target of several burglaries and vandalisms during past weeks. The citizen contacted police, who quickly responded to that location. Once on scene, police located and detained two fifteen-year-old males. One was located running from a classroom. The second was found hiding under a desk. Investigation revealed that the two had entered and/or damaged four classrooms.

Police have also connected them to several of the previous burglaries and vandalisms. Police will be obtaining petitions for the juveniles. Detective Joseph Antinarelli and Detective Joyce Williams are the lead investigators.
