Student Charged with Attempting to Sell Drugs at School

SUFFOLK, Va. (April 30, 2009) Suffolk Police have a charged a student with attempting to sell prescription drugs at Nansemond River High School yesterday. The student, a fifteen year old male, was approaching students in the cafeteria attempting to sell Percocet. Students promptly reported this activity to school administration.

Petitions were secured today by the school's resource officer for possession of a schedule II drug, possession of narcotics on school property and possession of narcotics with intent to distribute. It is unknown at this time if the subject will be detained. Under the school division's discipline policy, the student has been suspended and recommended for expulsion.
