Police Seek Suspect in Credit Card Theft

SUFFOLK, Va. (May 5, 2009) Suffolk Police are attempting to locate a subject that stole a credit card and then attempted to use it at a local restaurant. Police advise that on February 23, 2009, a subject entered the Applebee's located on Lakeview Parkway in the City of Suffolk.

The subject ordered take out meals and attempted to pay for the meals with a stolen credit card. The subject fled the business when an attempt was made to notify police.

Through investigation police were able to identify Delvon Anton Elliott, age 22, who's last known address is in the 300 block of Crown Arch in the City of Suffolk. Elliott is described as a black male, 5'9", 165 lbs. He has the word "Red" tattooed on the left side of his neck. Elliott is wanted for credit card theft, credit card fraud and contempt of court.

Anyone with information on Elliott's whereabouts is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If information given leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.

Detective John Jones is the lead investigator in this case.
