Police Attempt to Identify Suspects in Credit Card Theft

SUFFOLK, Va. (May 7, 2009) Suffolk Police are attempting to identify three subjects that are believed to have stolen and attempted to use a credit card that was taken from a parked vehicle in Suffolk. Police advise that during the evening hours of April 5, a purse containing credit cards was stolen from a vehicle that was parked in the driveway of a residence in the 6400 blk. of Ashmeade Ct.

On April 6, three subjects, two males and one female, entered Foot Locker located in the 3900 blk. of Victory Blvd. in Portsmouth and attempted to use one of the stolen cards. They attempted to purchase almost \$200 worth of merchandise but the card was declined.

Police have obtained surveillance video and are asking for the public's assistance in attempting to identify the suspects in this case. Anyone that might be able to identify any of these subjects is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If information given leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.

Detective David Wellford is the lead investigator in this case.
