### Police Investigate Credit Union Robbery

SUFFOLK, Va. (May 9, 2009) – Suffolk Police are investigating a credit union robbery. On May 8 at approximately 11:40 a.m., a male entered Bayport Federal Credit Union located at 1463 N Main Street. The subject, who was not wearing a mask, approached a teller, brandished a revolver and demanded money. The subject provided a bag for the money.

After receiving an undisclosed amount of currency and a dye pack, the subject fled the business traveling south on N. Main Street on foot. Police believe the dye pack quickly deployed as they received calls from witnesses describing a subject running across the shopping center parking lot, carrying a smoking bag. Police recovered evidence at the scene, including the suspect's t-shirt and cap.

The suspect is described as black, male, 5'6" with thin build, dark complexion, white tee shirt over black tee shirt, blue jeans and sneakers. Police are releasing photos of the suspect, taken from surveillance video.
