Suspect Identity Sought in CC Fraud

SUFFOLK, Va. (May 25, 2009) – Suffolk Police are investigating two cases of credit card fraud and asking for the public's assistance in identifying the suspect. Police advise that on March 24 and April 26, a male suspect entered the Seven Eleven located in the 1000 blk. of Centerbrook Ln and used fraudulent credit cards to purchase gift cards.

Police were able to obtain a photo of the suspect from surveillance video. Anyone that may be able to identify the suspect is asked to call Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If the information provided leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.

Detective John Jones is the lead investigator in this case.
