Police Seeking Assistance in Robbery Investigation

SUFFOLK, Va. (May 25, 2009) – Suffolk Police are asking for assistance in identifying two subjects that they would like to talk to in connection to the investigation of a local credit union. Police advise that on May 8, 2009, a subject armed with a handgun robbed the Bayport Federal Credit Union located in the 1400 blk. of North Main St. During the robbery, the suspect was given a dye pack. Police believe the dye pack deployed soon after the suspect exited the business.

During follow up investigation, police learned that currency that appeared to be stained had been converted to quarters at a local business with coin machines on May 10, 2009. Learning this information, detectives notified area businesses that had Coin Star type machines of the possibility of suspects attempting to convert the quarters back into paper currency.

Police are attempting to identify and would like to speak with two subjects that used the Coin Star machine at the Food Lion on Portsmouth Blvd. during the evening hours of May 10 to convert approximately 2,100 quarters to paper currency.
