Police Seek Identity of Check Forgery Suspect

SUFFOLK, Va. (May 31, 2009) – Suffolk Police are asking for assistance in identifying a subject that passed a forged check at a local Walmart. Police advise that on April 26, a subject used a forged check in the amount of \$902.41 to purchase items at Walmart located on North Main St.

Police advise that during the transaction the subject purchased a printer that cuts stencils typically used for scrap booking. They believe that this item may be used in the production of counterfeit checks. Police were able to obtain surveillance video of this subject and are asking for the public's assistance in identifying him. The suspect is a black male who was wearing a white t-shirt, dark pants and a red New York Yankees cap.

Anyone that may be able to assist police in identifying this subject is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If the caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000. Detective David Wellford is the lead investigator.
