## **UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (July 4, 2009) Early investigation into yesterday's ATV accident has reveals additional details of the incident. An adult neighbor and his four year old child were preparing to take a ride on a four wheeler, when the six year old also got on the four wheeler's seat in front of the four year old. When the adult started the vehicle, the six year old grabbed and engaged the throttle. The ATV flipped, injuring the six year old. Injuries appeared to be minor at first, but medical treatment was later found to be necessary.

This morning, the youth was listed as stable in the Pediatric ICU at C.H.K. D.

## **UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (July 3, 2009) An update has just been received from the hospital and the child is currently listed in serious but stable condition.

SUFFOLK, Virginia (July 3, 2009) A six year old little boy has been seriously injured in an a.t.v. accident in Suffolk. Emergency personnel were called just after 6 p.m. to the Holland Volunteer Fire Department where the child was brought after being injured in the 200 blk. of Bott Lane.

The child was taken by Nightingale to Sentara Norfolk Hospital. Police believe his injuries to be serious.

Investigation into the details of the incident is underway.
