SUFFOLK, Va. (August 18, 2009)– A twenty-five year old Suffolk man suffered serious injuries after being shot numerous times this afternoon. The shooting was reported just after 2 p.m. in the 700 blk. of Kilby Ave.

Upon arrival, police found Marquise Miller lying outside of a residence. Miller had been shot in the lower body. He was flown by Nightingale Helicopter to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital. Miller is currently undergoing surgery. No condition could be provided.

Suffolk Police have charged James Leonard Ash, age 58, of the 700 blk. of Kilby Ave. with one count of malicious wounding, one count of cut, stab or wound and one count of possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. Ash is being held at Western Tidewater Regional Jail without bond.

Police believe that Miller and Ash were involved in an altercation prior to the shooting but have given no additional details on a motive.
