Suffolk Police Investigate Shooting of Teen

SUFFOLK, Va. (October 20, 2008) – The Suffolk Police Department is investigating the shooting of a sixteen year old male early Sunday morning. Police were called in reference to shots being fired on Stacy Dr., just before 2:00 a.m., Sunday. While officers were in route, callers advised that someone had been shot.

When officers arrived, they located a sixteen year old male lying in the parking lot of Cogic Square Apartments. The youth had been shot several times. He was transported to Sentara Norfolk Hospital via Nightingale Helicopter where he underwent surgery. His current condition is unknown.

Police have learned that there was a large party inside one of the apartments and a disturbance occurred. That disturbance moved to the parking lot, where numerous shots were fired, possibly by more than one source. Four vehicles were also struck by bullets.

Police are attempting to locate a gold or cream colored Acura Legend, with a broken window, that was observed leaving the scene. They also believe that numerous people observed the events and would like to speak with them.
