**Suffolk Police Seek Suspect in Vehicle Break-in**

SUFFOLK, Va. (October 2, 2008) Suffolk Police are asking for assistance in locating a subject they believe broke into a vehicle and subsequently forged and uttered a check stolen during that incident. Police advise that between August 7 and August 8, 2008, Timothy Fisher Eaton, Jr. broke into a vehicle on Butler Avenue in the Riverview section of the city. A camera, memory cards, and checks were stolen from the vehicle.

On August 8, just before 9:30 a.m., Timothy Eaton cashed one of the stolen checks at a downtown Suffolk bank and received \$300. Felony warrants are on file for Eaton for two counts of grand larceny, forgery, uttering, and obtaining money under false pretenses. There is also an outstanding misdemeanor warrant on file for Timothy Eaton for threatening bodily harm.

He is described as a black male, age 19, approximately 6' and 140 lbs. His last known address is in the 200 block of Holladay Street.
