UPDATE

Suffolk Police have charged a 36 year old Carrollton man with murder and malicious wounding in a shooting that injured one man and killed another last night. Chad Andrew Kinney, of the 24000 blk. of Sugarhill Rd. Carrollton, was arrested at the scene of a double shooting on Eclipse Dr.

Investigation has revealed that Kinney was operating a vehicle around 9 p.m. on Eclipse Dr. when he encountered a vehicle operated by Glenn Joe Bauwens, age 42, of the 9300 blk. of Rivershore Dr. Bauwen's vehicle was also occupied by Dennis W. Bailey, age 29 of the 3000 blk. of Kings Hwy., and two females. The two drivers became involved in a road rage type altercation. Kinney pulled over at the entrance to a cemetery on Eclipse Dr. Bauwens also pulled over and Bauwens and Bailey approached Kinney's vehicle.

An altercation ensued and Kinney shot both Bauwen and Bailey from inside of the vehicle. Neither Bauwen or Bailey were armed at the time of the incident.

Kinney was arrested at the scene. The firearm that the suspect had used was located behind a tree. Kinney was interviewed by detectives. He was charged with 2nd degree murder, malicious wounding, use or display of firearm in committing felony and shooting from vehicles so as to endanger persons. He is currently being held at Western Tidewater Regional Jail.

Bailey is currently listed in fair condition at Sentara Norfolk General Hospital. Detective Carlos Gonzalez is the lead investigator.

SUFFOLK, Va. (October 18, 2009) – Just after 9:00 last night, Suffolk Police were notified of a possibly double shooting in the 8900 blk. of Eclipse Dr. near the cemetery. Units responded and located a possible suspect. That subject was detained.

Police located a gunshot victim on the ground in front of the cemetery. A second victim was located further down the road. Both victims were transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital. One victim was pronounced dead shortly after arrival at the hospital.

Police continue to investigate the incident. Further information will be provided as it becomes available.

No names have been released.
