## **TEEN CHARGED WITH BURGLARIES**

SUFFOLK, VA (May 13, 2011) A Suffolk teen has been charged with breaking into a neighbor's home four times in the past six months. When the sixteen-year-old male broke into the residence in the 1500 blk. of Wood Duck Rd. yesterday, he was met by the owner, who held the youth at gunpoint until police could arrive.

Police advise that the burglaries began in November with one burglary occurring that month, one burglary in April and two burglaries in May. In each of the incidents, the teen stole small items and prescription medication.

The youth was charged with four counts of breaking and entering and three counts of petit larceny. He is currently being detained at Chesapeake Juvenile Services.

Detective C. Sherer is the lead investigator on the case.
