POLICE SEEK TO IDENTIFY ROBBERY SUSPECTS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 20, 2011) Suffolk Police are investigating the robbery of a business and are asking for assistance from the public. Just before 3 p.m. Monday, two subjects entered the Approved Cash Advance, located at 829 W. Constance Rd. One of the subjects displayed a handgun and demanded money. The suspects took an undetermined amount of currency and fled the business.

The first suspect is described as a black male, in his early to mid 20's. The subject is approximately 6'0" and 150 lbs. He was wearing a long sleeve red t-shirt, blue doo rag and a red ball cap. The second subject is described as a black male in his early to mid 20's. He is approximately 5'5" to 5'7", wearing a black hat and glasses.

Police are releasing video from the robbery in hopes that someone might be able to identify the subjects. Anyone that may be able to assist police is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
