POLICE SEEK SUBJECT WANTED IN ASSAULTS

Suffolk, VA (May 28, 2011) – Suffolk Police are attempting to locate a subject wanted for assault and child endangerment. Dennis Roosevelt Harden, Jr., age 30, of the 1000 blk. of Davis Blvd. is accused of assaulting his ex-girlfriend on May 27. After that assault, Harden allegedly brought the couple's seven month old daughter to the mother's apartment and threw her on the ground. The child's grandmother ran outside to find the baby on the ground. Harden had fled the scene. There were no visible injuries to the baby.

Harden is aware he is wanted. He has been spotted and fled from police twice. Additional warrants for resisting arrest and obstruction of justice have been secured.

Police ask that anyone that may know Harden's whereabouts to call Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
