SUFFOLK POLICE INVESTIGATE ROBBERY

SUFFOLK, VA (July 12, 2011) Suffolk Police are investigating the robbery of an individual that occurred on Monday, July 11th in the parking lot of Wachovia Bank located in the 200 block of N. Main Street. Police advise that at approximately 10:00 p.m. Monday night, a female victim was approached by an unidentified subject after making an ATM withdrawal and returning to her vehicle. The subject displayed a silver handgun and demanded money, which the victim handed over. The victim was not injured.

The suspect is described as a white male in his late 30's or early 40's, 5'9" or 5'10", medium build with gray hair and close cut beard wearing dark clothing. He was last seen running away from the scene towards N. Main Street.

Anyone who may have information on this case is asked to contact Suffolk Police or the Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
