SUFFOLK, VA (August 3, 2011) Adrian T. Harvey was taken into custody today, August 3, 2011, in Garner, North Carolina, where a tip provided to police indicated he was employed. The Suffolk Police Department's Fugitive Unit coordinated with the Garner, North Carolina Police Department to make the arrest. Mr. Harvey was taken into custody by Garner Police without incident.

Police Seek Man Who Passed Counterfeit Bills

SUFFOLK, VA (August 1, 2011) On May 4, 2011, 26-year-old Adrian T. Harvey, of the 200 block of Elm Avenue in Portsmouth, uttered twenty-six counterfeit \$20 bills at the Wal-Mart located at 1200 N. Main Street. Mr. Harvey used the bills to purchase a Wal-Mart money card that was then loaded by the cashier.

On June 20, 2011, three felony warrants for forging bank notes, uttering bank notes, and possession of forged bank notes were secured against Mr. Harvey.

Anyone that may be able to assist police in locating Harvey is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.

Detective John Jones is the lead investigator on this case.
