Traffic Stop Nabs Two Burglary Suspects

SUFFOLK, VA (September 28, 2011) – A traffic violation led to the arrest of two burglary suspects Tuesday morning, after stolen car parts and accessories were observed in the car. Travis Deshaun Clark, 23 of the 700 blk. of Ashley Ave. and Gary Lewis Blount, 26 of S. 5th St., were in a vehicle stopped for improper display of a license tag, as well as an invalid state inspection.

Stolen items were observed in both the back seat and trunk of the vehicle. Officers then searched the surrounding area, where they discovered a business shed forced open in the 400 block of Carolina Road. The owner of the business was called, and subsequently identified the items as property of the business. Blount had fled the vehicle when it was stopped but was later identified apprehended by police.

Both Blount and Clark were charged with Burglary, Conspiracy to Commit a Felony, Grand Larceny, Larceny with Intent to Sell, and Possession of Burglarious Tools.
