POLICE SEEK IDENTITY OF SUSPECT USING STOLEN CARD

SUFFOLK, VA (October 27, 2011) The Suffolk Police Department is requesting the public's assistance in identifying a subject that has fraudulently used a credit card at several locations locally, as well as in Richmond.

The victim advised she lost her credit card on September 22, 2011 at the Wilco Convenience Store located at 3260 Western Branch Boulevard in Chesapeake. Since that time, the card was fraudulently used at several locations including Suffolk, Chesapeake, Virginia Beach, Midlothian and Richmond, Virginia on September 23, 2011 and September 24, 2011.

Police are releasing photos taken from a surveillance video on September 23, 2011, where the suspect used the card to purchase liquor at the ABC Store located at 6550 Hampton Roads Parkway in Suffolk.

Detective D. Wellford is the lead investigator.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers to not have to give their names or appear in

court. If information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
