SUFFOLK POLICE SEEK CREDIT CARD THEFT SUSPECT

SUFFOLK, VA (December 14, 2011) The City of Suffolk Police Department is asking for assistance to identify a suspect involved in a stolen credit card incident.

The victim's credit card was stolen from a location on Steeple Drive in the City of Suffolk on November 29, 2011 between 11:30 a.m. and 12 p.m. The card was later used that same day at the Wal-Mart located on College Drive in Northern Suffolk around 12:50 p.m. The suspect later tried to make another purchase using the same card at the same Wal-Mart but that transaction was denied.

Detective Jay Burton is the lead investigator.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
