SUFFOLK POLICE OFFICER PROMOTIONAL CEREMONY

Lieutenant Select: Michael Wise

Sergeant Michael Wise joined the Suffolk Police Department April 16, 1999. He graduated from the Chesapeake Police Academy as a member of class 40-B. As an officer, Sergeant Wise was assigned to uniform patrol and, during this time, was promoted to Master Police Officer in 2005. In 2007, Sergeant Wise was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and was assigned to Uniform Patrol until 2009 when he was assigned to the Professional Standards Division as the Sergeant in charge of Accreditation, Training and Inspections.

Sergeant Wise is married to his wife of 13 years, Kirsten. They have three children Zoie (10), Zane (9) and Peyton (6).

Sergeant Select: Master Police Officer Gary Myrick

Master Police Officer Gary Myrick joined the Suffolk Police Department on October 1, 1997.
