SUFFOLK POLICE SEEK SUSPECT IN CREDIT CARD FRAUD INCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (December 15, 2011) The City of Suffolk Police Department is asking for assistance to identify a suspect involved in a credit card fraud incident.

The suspect used the victim's credit card number to make two purchases at the Food Lion, located at 1010 Portsmouth Boulevard, on December 4, 2011 just after 4 p.m. It appears that the suspect captured the victim's credit card number to make a duplicate card. That card was used to purchase three American Express gift cards along with several smaller items.

Detective Jay Burton is the lead investigator.

Anyone with information is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
