UPDATE

SUFFOLK, Va. (April 9, 2010) – The woman that was transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital via Nightingale as a result of last night's accident, Carnia Riddick, is currently listed in fair condition. Riddick's four grandchildren, ages 5-11, as well as the driver of the other vehicle were also transported to area hospitals. Portsmouth Blvd. was reopened at approximately 11:15 p.m.

The case accident remains under investigation.

SUFFOLK, Va. (April 8, 2010) – East bound Portsmouth Blvd. is currently closed at Suburban Dr. due to a two vehicle accident. The accident was reported to police at approx. 9:40 p.m.

Six people have been transported to area hospitals. Three patients were transported to Sentara Obici Hospital. Three patients were transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital, one was via Nightingale helicopter.

Police are still on scene. No further details are available at this time.
