## **UPDATE**

SUFFOLK, VA (November 23, 2009) Tips to Crime Line helped police identify the subjects in a surveillance video and aid in a credit card larceny and fraud investigation. Now police are hoping that callers might be able to help them locate the subject that they were able to identify that they believe committed the crime.

Suffolk Police are attempting to locate Michael Todd Wiggins, 33, of the 100 block of Wexford Drive. Warrants are on file for Wiggins for one count of credit card theft, one count of credit card forgery, one count of credit card fraud and one count of criminally receiving goods. Wiggins is described as 5'11" and 244 lbs.

Police ask that anyone that knows Wiggins' whereabouts to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. Detective John Jones is the lead investigator in this case.

## **POLICE SEEK TO IDENTIFY SUBJECTS IN CREDIT CARD THEFT**

SUFFOLK, VA (November 15, 2009) Suffolk Police are requesting assistance in identifying two suspects in the larceny and use of a credit card. On November 3, 2009, suspects stole a purse from a vehicle while it was parked at Sentara Obici Hospital on Godwin Blvd. in the City of Suffolk.

A credit card from the purse was quickly used to make a purchase at a 7-Eleven, on Godwin Blvd, not far from the location of the larceny. Suffolk police are attempting to

identify and locate two subjects associated with that purchase which totaled \$79.01. The attached image is of the two subjects that made the purchase.

Police ask that anyone that can identify one or both of the subjects to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. Detective John Jones is the lead investigator in this case.
