UPDATE

SUFFOLK, Virginia (June 15, 2010) Suffolk Police advise that the driver in yesterday afternoon's crash, Sally Karako of Suffolk, was traveling westbound on Holland Rd operating a Ford F150 when she left the roadway and struck a ditch. The vehicle swerved back onto the roadway then off the roadway to the right, striking a ditch and a tree. Ms. Karako sustained serious injuries and the passenger, Darlene Karako, sustained minor injuries. Both were transported to Norfolk General Hospital for treatment. Sally Karako is listed in stable condition and will remain hospitalized. Darlene Karako was treated and released. The accident remains under investigation.

AFTERNOON ACCIDENT RT. 58

SUFFOLK, Virginia (June 15, 2010) Suffolk Police are currently investigating an accident that has traffic limited to one lane along westbound Rt. 58 near the intersection of Manning Road. Occurring at approximately 2:50 p.m., the single vehicle accident involved a late model Ford F150 pick-up truck, which lost control and hit a tree. Two female occupants were injured in the accident, with the passenger being transported with non life-threatening injuries to Norfolk General Hospital by ground transport, and the driver airlifted to Norfolk General Hospital. The extent of the driver's injuries are not known at this time, and the names of the occupants haven't been released. Suffolk Police continue to investigate. Officer Jonathan Bulls is the lead investigator.
