SUFFOLK, VA (November 6, 2010) Suffolk Police are investigating a bank robbery and are requesting assistance from the public. Police advise that yesterday just before 4 p.m., a subject entered the Bank of Hampton Roads located in the 2800 blk. of Godwin Blvd. The subject, a white, male, approximately 30-40 years old, with scruffy facial hair and thick rimmed glasses, approached the counter, produced a handgun and demanded money.

The suspect was given money which he placed in a bag. He then fled the bank on foot. The suspect was possibly seen getting into an older model, two tone Bronco II type SUV.

At the time of the robbery the suspect was wearing a brown "Southpole" pull over jacket, orange or red knit hat and brown boots.

Investigators obtained surveillance video from the scene. Several photos are being released in hopes that someone may recognize the suspect.

Anyone that can identify the suspect or has information on this robbery is asked to call Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000. Detective N. Boone is the lead investigator.
