MAN WANTED FOR COUNTERFEIT CHECKS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 14, 2010) A Newport News man is wanted on eighteen felony charges and Suffolk Police are asking for assistance from the public in locating him. Investigators advise that between August 16th and September 22nd, Dwight Bernard Jones, age 61, passed six counterfeit checks in the City of Suffolk. The checks were passed as Friendly Check Cashing, located in the 200 blk. of E. Washington, and Bunny's Pawn, located in the 100 blk. of W. Washington St.

Jones is described as a black, male, 5'9" and 185 lbs. His last known address is the 6000 blk. of Jefferson Ave. in Newport News.

Anyone with information on Jones' whereabouts is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
