Suffolk Police Investigating Larceny of Heat Pump

SUFFOLK, Va. (October 10, 2008) Suffolk Police are investigating the larceny of a heat pump and are asking the public for assistance. Police advised that sometimes between October 4 and October 5, 2008, suspect(s) unknown removed a 1.5 ton Goodman Heat Pump from behind an apartment located at 925 Brook Ave. Not only did the suspect(s) remove the heat pump, but they also removed the concrete slab on which the unit was positioned.

Suffolk Police Detective Kevin Hutt, who is investigating the case, advised that it appears that the suspect(s) that committed the larceny was "someone who had experience working with these types of units, as it was disassembled rather than torn out." The apartment unit is owned by the Suffolk Redevelopment Housing Authority.

Anyone with information on this crime is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock U Up. When calling Crime Line, the caller never has to give their name or appear in court. If the caller's information leads to an arrest, they could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
