Suffolk Police Investigate Bank Robbery

SUFFOLK, Va. (September 25, 2008) Suffolk Police are currently investigating the robbery of a North Main St. bank. Today at approximately 11:20 a.m., two subjects entered the First Federal Savings and Loan located at 1703 North Main St. The subjects, both black males wearing dark clothing, had their faces covered with bandanas. One of the subjects displayed a dark colored handgun and demanded money.

After receiving money, the subjects fled the bank running north bound on North Main Street. The suspects are described as follows:

Suspect #1 black, male, approx. 5'8", wearing a red hooded sweat shirt

Suspect #2 black, male, approx. 6 ft., wearing dark colored clothes & a jacket with stripes on the sleeves.

Det. C.M Gonzalez lead investigator. Anyone with information on the incident is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to leave their names or appear in court. If their call leads to an arrest, they could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
