UPDATE

The suspect that attempted to rob a church credit union fired a shot while in the business. Police advise that at approximately 12:41 p.m. they received a telephone call in ref. to an attempted armed robbery of the Metropolitan Church Credit Union.

Upon arrival, police learned that a lone black male had entered the location, produced a handgun and demanded money. When the teller ran to the rear of the building, the suspect fired a shot. No one was injured.

The suspect, who was wearing a black mask and gray sweat shirt/jacket, fled on foot.

Anyone that may have information on this incident is asked to call Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.

Suffolk Police Investigate Armed Robbery of Credit Union

SUFFOLK, VA (May 17, 2010) Suffolk Police are currently on scene of an armed robbery at Metropolitan Church Credit Union located in the 100 blk. of County St. The call was received at 12:41 p.m. The only suspect description available at this time is a black male, possibly in his twenties, wearing gray sweat shirt and a black mask.
