SUFFOLK POLICE SEEK FORGETFUL BURGLAR

SUFFOLK, VA (December 1, 2010) – Suffolk Police are seeking a man that allegedly broke into the pro shop of a local golf course and left his cell phone when he fled the scene. Police advise that on November 4, 2010, a suspect broke into the pro shop of the Riverfront Golf Course, located in the 5200 blk. of River Club Dr. The suspect took a safe that belonged to the business but left behind a cell phone close to where the safe had been located.

With the assistance of the forgotten item as part of the investigation, detectives were able to identify a suspect. Alonzo A. McKay, age 40, is wanted for one count of business burglary and one count of grand larceny. Police have been unable to locate McKay. His last known address is the 300 blk. of West 20th Street in Norfolk.

Anyone that knows McKay's whereabouts is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
