**POLICE SEEK IDENTITY OF LARCENY
SUSPECT IN CREDIT CARD THEFT**

SUFFOLK, VA (June 1, 2010) Suffolk Police are asking for assistance in identifying a subject involved in a larceny from a vehicle and use of a credit card stolen during that larceny. Police investigators advise that between May 7 and May 8, 2010, a laptop computer, GPS, and wallet, containing credit cards, were stolen from a vehicle in the 3900 blk. of Breezeport Way in Suffolk.

When the owner of the property notified his charge card company of the larceny, he was advised that a transaction and attempted transactions were made at a WalMart in Virginia Beach. Investigators were able to obtain video and stills of the suspect that used the stolen card. He is described as a black male, wearing glasses, in his late 30's to early 40's, wearing a tan shirt and dark pants. Police believe the subject was possibly operating a silver Chevrolet with a sun roof. No further description is available on the vehicle.

Detective Q. Beers is the lead investigator on the case.

Anyone that may be able to identify this subject is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If the caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
