## **POLICE SEEK IDENTITY OF SUSPECT IN USE OF COUNTERFEIT CREDIT CARD**

SUFFOLK, VA (July 7, 2010) Suffolk Police are asking for assistance in identifying a subject that used a counterfeit credit card at two different locations. Investigators advise that on June 1, 2010, a subject used a counterfeit credit card at both the Food Lion located in the 1000 blk. of Portsmouth Blvd and the Walmart located in the 1200 blk. of N. Main St. Between the two locations, the suspect was able to obtain more than \$1,000 worth of merchandise.

Police were able to obtain still photographs of the suspect from one of the store's surveillance videos and are requesting assistance from the public in identifying him.

Anyone that may be able to identify this subject is asked to contact Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If the caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
