## **POLICE SEEK SUSPECTS IN LARCENY CASES**

SUFFOLK, VA (June 1, 2010) Suffolk Police are asking for assistance in locating two subjects with active warrants. In the first case, police are attempting to locate Curtis J. Harris, age 41, of the 100 blk. of S. Main St. Suffolk. He is wanted for one count of grand larceny. Harris is alleged to stolen several deposits from the Hair Cuttery located in the 1400 blk. of N. Main St. in early April.

In an unrelated case, police are looking for James C. Cowling Jr. age 42, of the 6900 blk. of Crittenden Rd., Cowling is wanted for third offense petit larceny and larceny with intent to sell, both felonies. These charges are the result of an investigation into the larceny of dirt bikes from a shed on April 16.

Detective John Jones is the lead investigator on both cases.

When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If the caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
